Registration / Check In: 9:45 AM

Activities Begin Promptly at 10:30AM

Robinson Hollow Camp, Richford New York

Reunion headquarters and check-in in the cabin. Lots of space throughout the site. Pond adjacent for dog swimming. Primitive restroom facilities available.

From Albany, Buffalo, Rochester - NYS Thruway to Interstate 81 South (at Syracuse). Continue with directions from Syracuse below.

From Syracuse - Interstate 81 South to Exit # 12 toward RT281, turn left on RT281. RT 281 turns into NY-13. In Dryden, stay straight on South St./RT 38. Cont. 5 miles & turn right on Slaterville Rd/CR 137. CR137 then becomes CR 117. Cont. 3.3 miles & turn left on Flatiron RD/CR-117A, 1 mile, turn left onto Slaterville Rd/NY-79, In 1.5 miles turn left onto Robinson Hollow Rd

From Binghamton - Interstate 81 North to Exit # 8 (RT-26 Exit) toward US 11/Whitney Pt/RT-206) Turn right onto NY-26. .6 miles turn left onto US-11/NY-26, cont on US-11. 2.3 miles stay straight on RT-79/Main St. Continue 15.7 miles, turn right on Robinson Hollow Rd

From Ithaca & Elmira - Take NY-79 E for 12.9 miles, turn left on Robinson Hollow Rd

Once on Robinson Hollow Rd, directions for everyone:

Go approximately 1 mile, and the driveway is on the left. Before the driveway, you will pass a brown home then a light blue home. The driveway is on the left across from a white house, before a barn and dirt area w/farm equipment/trucks. If you get to the dirt seasonal road Y you have gone a little too far.

Come up the driveway, past the cabin, and half-way up the field lane, a few hundred yards past the pond, you can turn into and park in the middle field.

- Admission charge is just \$5 per Golden household. Proceeds help fund GRRCNY's ongoing public education, veterinary care and other activities..
- All participants must check in upon arrival and receive a Reunion admission name badge. No admission to events without a badge!
- For the comfort and safety of all participants we require that all dogs be kept on lead at all times unless participation in a particular exercise dictates otherwise. We expect 50+ Golden in the camp. Owners are cautioned to mind where your dog's nose is at all times. A biting or fighting incident would spoil the day for us all!
- Please remember we are guests. All owners will be expected to clean up after their dogs. Bring a supply of poop bags!
- GRCCNY reserves the right to excuse from this event anyone not in compliance with our Reunion rules, and to rescue any distressed animal from a vehicle not providing adequate ventilation.
